

Job Description for Olds Community Chorus Director.

The Choir Director for the Olds Community Chorus also acts as Artistic Director and Conductor. This would include scheduling choir rehearsals and ensuring that choir members attend rehearsals regularly. Selecting individual choir members to perform solos. Providing the necessary guidance and direction during choir rehearsals to assist choir members in achieving the correct tone, pitch, rhythm, tempo, and harmony. Choose the music and how it will be presented. Provide program list to Librarian to assemble music packages. Lead the orchestra or accompanist and ensure that musicians play with one coherent sound, balancing the melody, timing, rhythm and volume. Give feedback to vocalists, musicians and section leaders on sound and style. Locate other musicians or guest artists as required. Attend Board meetings as required.

Extra things provided by current Director include meeting with possible sponsors or advertisers to promote upcoming projects or concerts. Individually coach members for their appropriate musical selections. Record musical rehearsal parts for members to privately rehearse. All things are prepared with the Values of the choir to Sing, Learn, Grow.

Job Description for the Olds Community Chorus Accompanist.

The Accompanist for the Olds Community Chorus is under the direction of the Director during rehearsals and concerts. They may assist the director in the leading of section rehearsals and concerts, and the coaching of individuals and small ensembles, and to do other related work as required. Perform piano accompaniment for practice, rehearsals, and performances. Lead section rehearsals by playing parts, identifying student mistakes and problem areas, correcting mistakes and providing the right notes and rhythms. Locate and select concert musicians as necessary. Perform other related duties as assigned.

Guest Artists, (or Featured Artist,) performing with or for performances of the Olds Community Chorus enhance the audience experience of the program. Rehearsals may include a combined rehearsal with the Director, Accompanist and Guest Artist without the choir. Any instruments, other than piano, are provided by the Guest Artist.
